
Capital Budget

First year costs of the Capital Improvement
Plan – these are the projects and expenditures requiring a vote by the Board

Alamance County has a Five (5) Year CIP, which includes the needs of the Courts, Alamance-Burlington School System (ABSS), Alamance Community College (ACC) and County Government

Capital Project Definitions

- Acquisition or construction of any physical facility for the community
- Acquisition of land or an interest in land for the community
- Acquisition or construction of public utilities
- Ongoing acquisition of assets such as major equipment or physical systems (i.e., computer technology, radio systems, major specialized vehicles, etc.)
- Modification to facilities, including additions to existing facilities which increase the square footage, useful life, or value of the facility
- Capital maintenance or replacement projects on existing facilities

Highlighting Projects and Expenditures

FY24-25 Capital Budget Expenditure Drivers

ABSS \$3.9 million in Pay-as-you-go funding:

- Safety Updates: \$1.5 million
- Deferred Maintenance: \$770,000
- Athletic Site Improvements: \$325,000
- Vehicle Replacements (Maintenance and Activity Bus): \$480,000
- Playground and Classroom Replacements: \$250,000
- Emergency Contingency: \$500,000

FY24-25 Capital Budget Expenditure Drivers

ACC \$536,000 in Pay-as-you-go funding:

- Campus Renovations and Repairs: \$200,000
- Campus Safety Upgrades: \$100,000
- Equipment/Vehicle Replacement: \$10,000
- **Roof Repairs: \$26,000**
- System Upgrades (IT, Fire, Mechanical/HVAC): \$200,000

FY24-25 Capital Budget Expenditure Drivers

Alamance County \$2.83 million in Pay-as-you-go funding:

- Detention Center Roof Replacement & HVAC repairs: \$1.5M
- Courthouse Repairs & Upfit: \$350,000
- Athletic Field Updates: \$1M

Several Other County Projects Funded Through Various Sources (Installment Loan, State Grant, Solid Waste Fees)

- 911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Replacement: \$5.2M
- Federally-mandated Public Safety Radio Replacement: \$5M
- Phase 1 Emergency Services Center Upfit and Fiber: \$5M
- Landfill Roof Replacement: \$38,400

Potential Future Impacts

FY24-25 Pay Go projects will not result in the need for future additional revenues.

FY24-25 Installment loan-funded projects may result in a future need for additional revenue to support on-going debt service beginning in FY27-28.
